Proceeds from the 2010 Tri Delta Art Show for Charity will fund four-year, two-year, and one-year need-based college scholarships. These scholarships are awarded to outstanding Houston area high school senior women recommended by their school counselors. The scholarships are awarded annually and the proceeds may be used to cover tuition, fees and books. Funds are sent directly to the recipient's college. Scholarships are monitored each semester to confirm our recipients continued academic success. A minimum of \$20,000 to fund a first prize 4-year, \$5000/year Community Scholarship.
